APA 6th referencing style What is a direct quotation? A direct quotation reproduces word-for-word material taken directly from another author's work, or from your own previously published work. If the quotation is fewer than 40 words, incorporate it into your paragraph and enclose it in double quotation marks.

Direct quotations - APA 6th referencing style - Library ...

Section 6.05 of the Manual (6th ed.) provides guidance for direct quotations from material without pagination. When paragraph numbers are visible, use them in place of page numbers. Otherwise, include in your citation the heading and the number of the paragraph that follows it. See the post on how to cite a Kindle for an example.

When including a direct quotation in text, be sure to enclose the quote in double quotation marks and provide the author, date of publication, and page number (or paragraph number and/or section heading if there are no page numbers).

How do I reference a direct quote from a web page in APA ...

when reproducing an exact definition (see Section 6.22 of the Publication Manual), when an author has said something memorably or succinctly, or. when you want to respond to exact wording (e.g., something someone said). Instructors, programs, editors, and publishers may establish limits on the use of direct quotations.

Quotations - APA Style

Only use page numbers for a direct quote. Make sure the source information in parentheses matches with your works cited. The punctuation for the sentence goes AFTER the parenthesis. If your quote is forty words or more, set it off in a block text by beginning a new line, indenting one inch, and do not add quotation marks.

In-text Citations - Citation Help for APA, 6th Edition ...

Direct quotes When you include a sentence or words reproduced from a text (book, article, etc.) in your writing, you should follow the APA style for direct quotations. Your in-text citation for direct quotations should include author, date, and page numbers. Short direct quotes (fewer than 40 words)

In-text citation - APA 6th Referencing Style Guide ...

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when "paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work" (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

APA citation basics When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

Citing a Direct Quote from a Video. You may want to include a direct quote from a YouTube video within your paper. While your reference page citation for the quote will be the same as a citation for the whole video, your in-text citation will need a timestamp to help readers easily access the quote (Publication manual, p. 274). It is commonly accepted to only include a timestamp for the beginning of the quote, but you may use a timestamp range if you think it would be helpful.

The APA citation style (6th Edition) is a parenthetical author-date style, so you need to put the author's last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.

An indirect citation or secondary source is when the ideas of one author are published in another author's text but you have not read or accessed the original author's work. Include both the original author and the author of the work where quote/idea was found in the in-text reference. Add "as cited in" before the author in the in-text ...

Indirect citation or secondary source - APA 6th ...

Direct Quote Quoted material should be reproduced word-for-word. Always include the author's last name, year of publication, and page number (s). Use 'p.' for a single page number (Example: p.

Direct Quote - APA Style Guide - LibGuides at Western ...

APA in-text citation is generally written with the last name of the author and year of publication separated by a comma inside the parentheses, but for direct quotations, the page or paragraph number has to be included.

Numbers in parentheses refer to specific pages in the APA 6th Edition manual. How to Cite a Direct Quote (pp.170-171) When you incorporate a direct quotation into a sentence, you must cite the source. Fit quotations within your sentences, enclosed in quotation marks, making sure the sentences are grammatically correct.

Quotes & Paraphrasing - APA Citation Style 6th Edition ...

Direct quotations of material without page numbers are covered in Section 8.28 of the APA Publication Manual, Seventh Edition. This guidance has been expanded from the 6th edition. Provide a paragraph number (count the paragraphs manually if they are not numbered).

Direct Quotation of Material Without Page Numbers

The sixth edition of APA style also had the exact way to cite the quote in the reference section of the paper. If the quote is longer than 40 words, it must start on a new line. Indent the quote by 5 spaces, or a 1/2-inch by Microsoft Word's ruler. Double-space the quote, and do not use quotation marks.
