4K refers to one of two high definition resolutions: 3840 x 2160 pixels or 4096 x 2160 pixels. 4K is four times the pixel resolution, or twice the line resolution (2160p), of 1080p (1920 x 1080 pixels). The other high definition resolutions in use are 720p and 1080i.

With 4K now here, that horizontal size has now been standardized to a resolution of 4096 pixels wide. The 4K DCI standard specifically calls for a resolution of 4096 x 2160 pixels, which amounts to an aspect ratio of 1:1.85. Let ' s talk about that aspect ratio for a moment.

4k resolution is named for the approximately 4,000 (4k) pixels that make up the horizontal resolution across the image. More specifically, the resolution is 3840 × 2160, which gives 8.3 million total pixels – 4 times that of 1080p. (4k is sometimes called 2160p, and is also known as QFHD – Quad Full High Definition.)

This resolution, sometimes referred to as 4K UHD or 4K × 2K, has a 16:9 aspect ratio and 8,294,400 pixels.
