Deploy: If enabled, specifies whether or not the project will be deployed when the Run or Deploy commands are used with the selected solution build configuration. This check box only appears for deployable projects. For example, the database project is ok, the.NET MVC project is not.

Clicking "Deploy" from the Android project's menu in the solution explorer is completely ignored. It doesn't start the build process, it doesn't even clear the output log that was there from before. Restarting Visual Studio, doing a rebuild, then debug/deploy works again.

Run Build > Clean Solution and then use Debug > Start Debugging or Debug > Start Without Debugging to attempt to build and deploy your project to your Android device. After the build fails, open the View > Output window in Visual Studio and set Show output from to Build.
